




Download the "Smart Hearing" for Apple devices

The "Smart Hearing" makes it easy to control and adjust your hearing aids with your compatible Apple device. Access apps for iPhone, iPad and iPod touch - download on the App Store by following these steps:

Step One: On a compatible Apple device, click on "App Store."



Step Two: Type in "Smart Hearing" in the search box.



Step Three: Tap "GET" on your device. Follow the screen prompts to finish downloading.



Step Four: Once the app has installed, tap the app from your Home screen or Apps Library.

Download the "Smart Hearing" for Android devices

The "Smart Hearing" makes it easy to control and adjust your hearing aids with your compatible Android device. Downloading the app by following these steps:

Step One: On a compatible Android device, click on "Google Play Store."



Step Two: Type in "Smart Tune" in the search box.



Step Three: Tap "GET" to download. Follow the screen prompts to finish downloading.

Step Four: Once the app has installed, tap the app from your Home screen or Apps Screen.



[PAIRING WITH YOUR HEARING AID]

- 1. Turn on the hearing aids.
- 2. Enable Bluetooth on the phone.
- 3. Search the name "G. Sound Buds" of the device.
- 4. Tap to connect your hearing aid with your phone.
- 5. Tap "Smart Hearing" to started. On the botton of first screen, top "connect aids"
- *Search and connect the device name of "G.SoundBuds-L" or "G.SoundBuds-R".
- 6. You are now ready to go.

If you need to re-pair your phone device

- 1. Start by removing the old pairing by going to the Settings menu.
- 2. Tap Accessibility.
- 3. Select Hearing Devices and tap Forget this device.
- 4. Turn your phone device off and on again and re-pair the hearing aids to the device. If you need more information, contact your hearing care professional.


Main Screen:

1.Top menu bar:

Mode switch accordingly to best suit you.

2.Mode cards

Swipe to select a mode that suit your listening environment.

3.Adjust volume

Use the volume slider to adjust the volume of your hearing aids. If you are using the Standard program, an additional slider for the streaming device will appear, you can adjust the volume for each hearing aid separately.

4. Connection status

Gray colour will be displayed if dis-connected. To re-connect, bring the hearing aid close to your device and tap the icon.

5.Battery status

Keep track of the battery status seen the progress of the batteries charging when the hearing aids are placed in the charger charging progress will be display when on charge.
